- 9-inch square piece of fabric in a contrasting color for your crest
- Adhesive felt letters
- Adhesive foam flowers and shapes
- Adhesive gemstones
- Pom-poms and fabric glue
- Fabric markers
- Scissors



Make Your Own SHERO Cape!

Crafting is about so much more than glue and glitter. It's about unleashing your creativity and expressing what makes you YOU. There's always something to learn, and tons of inspiration to be had, so come along and join the adventure!

How You'll Do It

- **1** Print and cut out the cape template and your favorite crest template.
- Fold a large rectangle of the cape fabric in half lengthwise. Place the cape template with TOP at the top edge of the fabric, and FOLDED EDGE at the folded edge. Trace around the cutting lines of the template with fabric markers. Cut along the traced lines through both layers of folded fabric. Ask for help cutting if you need it.



- Trace your crest template on the contrasting fabric square, using fabric markers, and cut out the crest shape. Glue it to the back of the cape with fabric glue.
- **4** Decorate your cape. Here are some tips!
 - ► A crest can show what makes you a super-shero! Add your symbol, initials, name, or troop number to the crest or back of the cape.
 - Create pom-pom borders, phrases, or shapes.
 - ▶ Layer foam flowers and add gemstones to the centers.



While you're making your show-stopping SHERO cape, think about what being a hero means to you and what kind of hero you hope to be to others. Share your thoughts with friends and family, and ask what being a hero means to them. Finish up by posing in a SHERO photo shoot with them to show off your G.I.R.L. pride. They might even be inspired to make their very own cape—sweet!
