#2 Start sketching!

- ◆ Sketch the main characters.
- ◆ Draw the places where your story happened.
- ◆ Show the main events and emotions of your story.

"Action boxes" like this one can be used to let your narrator speak.

- ◆ How did you (or will you) use your earnings?
- ◆ What did you learn?
