Girl Scout National Plan for Vacation Day Sweepstakes Official Rules ("Official Rules")

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS SWEEPSTAKES. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT WILL NOT INCREASE OR IMPROVE CHANCE OF WINNING. [INTERNET ACCESS REQUIRED.] VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

1. <u>Sweepstakes Description</u>

The Girl Scout [National Plan for Vacation Day] Sweepstakes ("<u>Sweepstakes</u>"), sponsored by the Girl Scouts of the United States of America ("<u>Sponsor</u>"), allows eligible individuals ("<u>Entrants</u>") to enter the Sweepstakes by purchasing a 3- or 5-Day pass for the 2023 Girl Scout Convention ("<u>Event</u>") via the 2023 Girl Scout Convention registration site at <u>https://girlscouts.cventevents.com/2023GirlScoutConvention</u> ("<u>Registration Site</u>").

MANY WILL ENTER, BUT ONLY FIVE WINNERS will be randomly selected by the Sponsor from the Entrants who have complied with all of the terms and conditions of these Official Rules (each a "<u>Prize Winner</u>").

This Sweepstakes is in no way sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with Cvent, Inc. ("<u>Cvent</u>"), The Walt Disney Company, its subsidiary and affiliates ("<u>Disney</u>"), Instagram, Inc. ("<u>Instagram</u>"), Meta Platforms, Inc. ("<u>Meta</u>"), or Twitter, Inc. ("<u>Twitter</u>"). Entrants are providing information to Sponsor and not to Disney, Cvent, Instagram, Meta, or Twitter.

2. <u>Sweepstakes Period</u>

Entry into the Sweepstakes by purchasing a 3- or 5-Day pass to the Event via the Registration Site begins on January 31, 2023 at 12:00 a.m. ET and ends on February 21, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. ET ("<u>Sweepstakes</u> <u>Period</u>"). Sponsor's clock is the official clock and sole determinant for the purposes of determining the validity of an entry in the Sweepstakes.

3. Eligibility

The Sweepstakes is open only to legal residents of one of the fifty (50) states of the United States, the District of Columbia, or Puerto Rico. The Sweepstakes is void where prohibited by law. The Sweepstakes is not open to any employees, directors, or officers of Sponsor or of Sponsor's subsidiaries, or affiliated councils, and the immediate family members (defined as spouse, parent, child, sibling, and their respective spouses, regardless of where they live) and household members (whether related or not) of such employees. 4. How to Enter

TO ENTER THE SWEEPSTAKES, ENTRANTS MUST:

Visit the Registration Site and purchase a 3-Day or 5-Day Pass for the Event hosted by Sponsor. To enter, registrants must complete the online registration form by 11:59 PM ET on February 21, 2023 (the "<u>Submission</u>"). A Cvent account ("<u>Account</u>") is required to enter using this Sweepstakes Entry Method and is available for free at https://girlscouts.cventevents.com/2023GirlScoutConvention. All terms and conditions of cventevents.com apply.

Entrants are limited to one Submission per person. Multiple Accounts may not be used by an Entrant and any Entrant found to use multiple Accounts to enter will be ineligible. Any other attempted form of online entry is void and will not be accepted. Any use of automatic, programmed, or like methods of entry (e.g. bots or scripts) will void all Submissions by such methods.

Message and data rates may apply if an Entrant enters the Sweepstakes on their mobile device. Not all mobile telephone / wireless providers carry the service necessary to participate in the Sweepstakes. Entrants should consult their wireless provider's pricing plans. Mobile entry is not required to enter or win.

In the event of a dispute as to any registration, the authorized Account holder used to register will be deemed to be the Entrant. Each potential Prize Winner may be required to show proof of being an authorized Account holder.

All Submissions become the sole and exclusive property of Sponsor, and receipt of Submissions will not be acknowledged or returned. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, illegible, stolen, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible, misdirected, technically corrupted or garbled Submissions, which will be disqualified, or for problems of any kind whether mechanical, human or electronic. Only fully completed Submissions are eligible. Proof of submission will not be deemed to be proof of receipt by Sponsor.

5. <u>Alternative Method of Entry</u>

To enter without registering for the Event, Entrant may send a postcard or a card to Girl Scouts of the USA, Attention: Convention Team, 420 Fifth Avenue, NY, NY 10018, which includes Entrant's printed or legibly handwritten name, mailing address, phone number, date of birth, email address, and mail with proper postage. All write-in entries must be received by February 21, 2023. There is a limit of one (1) write-in entry per envelope/postcard. Each envelope/postcard is considered one (1) entry into the Sweepstakes. Multiple entries submitted or completed by anyone other than the Entrant are void. No mechanical reproductions will be accepted. Write-in entries must contain all entry fields outlined above; otherwise, they are void and will not be eligible to win.

6. Winner Determination

Five (5) potential Prize Winners in all will be selected at random by Sponsor on February 23, 2023 from among the eligible Entrants who entered the Sweepstakes during the Sweepstakes Period. Each potential Prize Winner will be notified by email within two (2) business days of selection. Upon notification, the potential Prize Winner will have two (2) business days to claim their Prize with an email response to convention@girlscouts.org. If the potential Prize Winner cannot be contacted within two (2) business days of first notification attempt, if Prize or Prize notification is returned as undeliverable, if the potential Prize Winner rejects the Prize, or in the event of noncompliance with these Official Rules, the Prize will be forfeited and a new potential Prize Winner will be selected at random by Sponsor from among the eligible Entrants. Upon Prize forfeiture, no compensation will be given.

There will be five (5) Prize Winner for this Sweepstakes, each receiving two (2) Disney theme park tickets for use at Magic Kingdom Park, EPCOT, Disney's Animal Kingdom, or Disney's Hollywood Studios (the "<u>Prize</u>"). The approximate retail value of each Prize is \$288.00. The Prize Winner should please allow four (4) weeks for delivery. The Prize is subject to market availability and Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value in its sole discretion. The Prize is not transferable, assignable or redeemable for cash. The Prize is limited to that specified above; all other unspecified costs, fees, and expenses associated with the Prize award, receipt, and use are solely the responsibility of the Prize Winner. Any and all federal, state and local taxes on the Prize, if any, are the sole responsibility of the Prize Winner.

Everything regarding this Sweepstakes, including Prize components, is provided "as is" without any warranty, representations, expressed or implied, in fact or in law, relative to the quality, conditions, fitness or merchantability of any aspect of the Prize.

Sponsor reserves in its sole discretion the right to suspend, withhold, modify or terminate any aspect of the Prize at any time, should Sponsor determine that the Prize Winner or the parent or legal guardian of a Prize Winner violates the values of the Girl Scouts, Girl Scout Promise, or Girl Scout Law.

8. Official Clock and Use of Internet

Sponsor's computer will be the official clock for the Sweepstakes. Sponsor, Sponsor's subsidiaries and affiliates, and their respective advertising, promotion, or production agencies are not responsible for technical, hardware, software, or telecommunications malfunctions of any kind; lost or unavailable network connections; failed, incorrect, incomplete, inaccurate, garbled, or delayed electronic communications caused by the sender; or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in this Sweepstakes which may limit the ability to participate (including but not limited to defects/errors/malfunctions), or by any error that may occur in the entry process or the Sweepstakes. 10. Privacy

By entering a Submission, Entrant agrees that Sponsor may post their Promotional Content on any and all Media Accounts, and that Sponsor may publicize information about Entrant or the Prize Winner. 11. Indemnification

By entering a Submission, Entrant agrees to release, discharge, indemnify, and hold harmless Sponsor, Girl Scout councils, Disney, Cvent, Instagram, Meta, Twitter, and their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, related companies, advertising and promotion agencies, and the directors, officers, employees, shareholders, and agents ("Indemnitees") of each from and against any liability, injury, death, loss or damages to Entrant or any person or entity, including without limitation damage to personal or real property, caused in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, by reason of their participation in the Sweepstakes (or related activities), their acceptance, possession, or use/misuse of the Prize, or from any delay in receiving the Prize and/or any subsequent prize, if applicable. By participating, Entrant agrees to the exclusive jurisdiction of such courts. Sponsor's failure to enforce any provision of these Official Rules shall not constitute the waiver of such provision.

14. Severability

If any provision(s) of these Official Rules are held to be invalid or unenforceable, all remaining provisions hereof will remain in full force and effect.
