

Brownie Elf's Making Change Game

Directions

1. Print the customer cards and elf money. (If you want to save ink, print them in black-and-white and color them yourself. Or, print one page at a time. You can also use real money instead of elf money.)
2. Cut out the customer cards and elf money.
3. Ask your parents for the following:
 - Coins (four quarters, eight dimes, four nickels)
 - a die



Here's how to play:

1. Each person rolls the die one time. The person who rolled the highest number goes first.
2. Then, this player will choose a customer card, read it out loud, and pretend to be the cashier by using the elf money and coins to make change for that customer.
3. Once the first player has made the correct amount of change, the next players should take a turn by repeating steps 2-3.
4. Continue taking turns until you finish all the cards—or until you decide you're super-duper change makers!

Grandma Elf wants to buy a pound of cheese. She hands you \$5. How much change should you give her?




Peanut butter \$3.75

Aunt Fiona wants to buy peanut butter. She hands you a \$5 bill. How much change should you give her?




Strawberry jam \$3

Cousin Lorna wants to buy two tomatoes. She hands you \$10. How much change should you give her?




Head of lettuce \$2.50

Elspeth MacGinty wants to buy a head of lettuce. She hands you \$5. How much change should you give her?




Bunch of carrots \$1.50

Mr. MacGinty wants to buy two apples. He hands you \$10. How much change should you give him?




Head of broccoli \$2.75

Aunt Fiona wants to buy a box of elf-aroni that costs \$2.25. She gives you \$3. How much change should you give her?




Package of cookies \$4.50

Brownie Elf wants to buy a package of cookies. She hands you \$10. How much change should you give her?




Soup \$1

Cousin Lorna wants to buy soup. She hands you \$10. How much change should you give her?




Elf cereal \$3.50

Brownie Elf wants to buy an elf hat. She hands you \$10. How much change should you give her?




Doll \$10.25

Cousin Lorna wants to buy a doll. She hands you \$20. How much change should you give her?




Elf bracelet \$10.50

Cousin Lorna wants to buy a soccer ball. She hands you \$11. How much change should you give her?




Elf tights \$3

Cousin Hamish wants to buy an elf sweater. He gives you \$10. How much change should you give him?




Elf shirt \$5.50

Brownie Elf wants to buy sneakers. She gives you \$20. How much change should you give her?




Notebook \$2.25

Grandma Elf wants to buy movie popcorn and soda that costs \$8.50. She gives you \$20. How much change should you give her?




Dance lessons \$10.75
