Behaviors of a G.I.R.L.

Go-getter

- > The girl who has great ideas for what her troop can do with a group of younger girls
- The girl who vows to be the top cookie seller in her troop, makes a plan, and makes it happen
- The girl who gathers her Girl Scout friends to volunteer in the community with her

Innovator

- The girl who hits a roadblock in a project so finds a different way to approach it
- The girl who notices the latch missing from the camp gate and replaces it with a monkey's fist knot she learned to make at camp
- The girl who changes up the games she had planned to lead with a Brownie troop when she arrives to find one girl on crutches.
- > The girl who comes up with a fun new recipe for the council's Girl Scout Cookie bake-off
- The girl who figures out how to recycle common household products, like turning K-cups into honeybee houses for her Girl Scout camp

Risk-taker

- The girl who goes camping with her troop as her first time away from home EVER
- The girl who volunteers to be the first in her cabin to try paddle boarding
- The girl who stands up to some boys teasing her troop about selling cookies at a booth
- > The girl who defends another girl in the troop when a bully at school starts calling her names

Leader

- The girl who volunteers to be in charge of her troop's service project
- The girl who listens to different opinions of her troop members about a problem and suggests a solution that combines all of their ideas
- The girl who's a CIT (counselor in training) and is especially good at helping homesick girls adjust and have fun at camp
- The girl who motivates everyone to pull off their best cookie sale ever
- The girl who recruits her fellow troop members to step up and build a Girl Scout float for the community parade
